NSFT/CA/ INFRASTRUCTURE UPDATE AT NSFT

30th June '25

Dear Valued Customers,

As you are aware, NSFT was handed over the container terminal (JNPCT) by JNPA and operation of this terminal was commenced on 11th February 2023 . NSFT simultaneously undertook the upgradation, strengthening of the 680-meter berth and enhancing supporting facilities. During the course of this project, we ensured uninterrupted operations by having minimum 340-meter berth available for vessel operation. The whole 680 m berth is now widened to 60.5 metres for deploying quay cranes of 30-meter rail span which will enable NSFT to handle large size vessels.

We are pleased to inform that the expansion project of NSFT is in the completion stage and the Five number of Super Post Panamax Quay Cranes (22-Row outreach) have arrived at NSFT. Details are as below.

- QC Nos. 10 and 11 (First batch): Arrived in March 2025 and already deployed for vessel operation.
- QC Nos. 12, 13, and 14 (Second batch): Arrived in June 2025 and are currently undergoing trial runs. These cranes are expected to be fully operational by 10th August 2025.

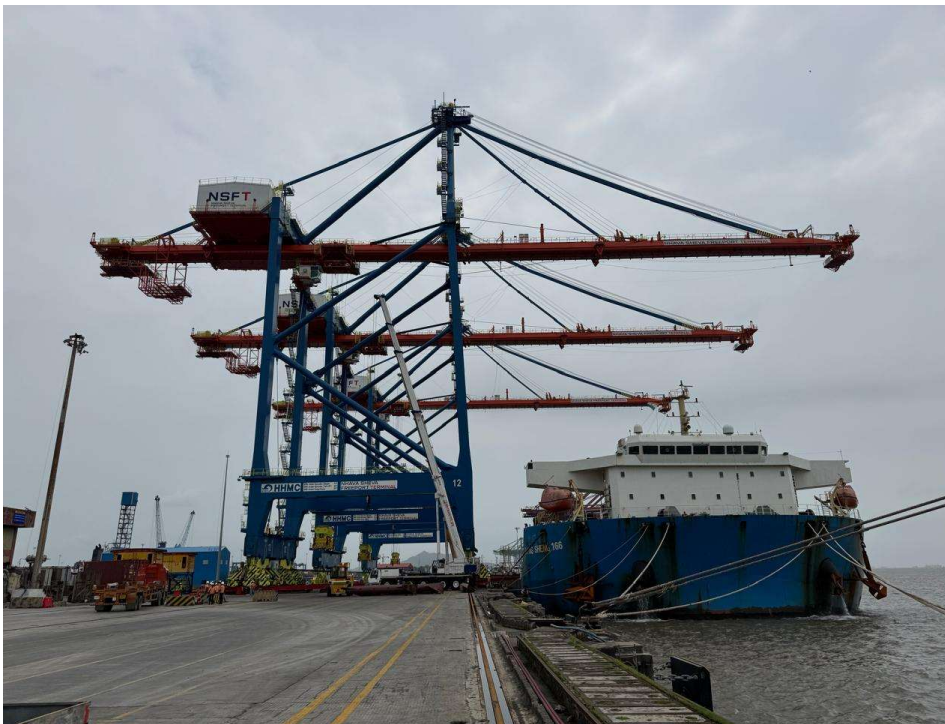
The full 680-meter berth will be available for berthing vessels by end July 2025. With the enhanced infrastructure and addition of new cranes, NSFT will have the annual handling capacity of 1.8 million TEUs.

For your reference, the infrastructure at NSFT during August 2025 will be as follows.
